Code of Conduct for Children and Young People

Luctonians Cricket Club provides opportunities for young people between the ages of 5 and 17 to receive coaching and competitive match playing opportunities in Herefordshire Cricket Board organized competitions.

All coaching is directed by qualified coaches who are trained and have been screened for their suitability for working with young people.

In addition we advise all Junior Members of the standards expected to be upheld whilst involved with the club.

They are as follows;

- Members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
- All members must respect their fellow team mates and opponents
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late
- Members must wear suitable kit – trainers, cricket shirt (or suitable sports shirts), tracksuit or cricket trousers– for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club
